Dear Cup Church family and friends,

A new calendar for the kitchen bulletin board, and (traditionally) a new opportunity to consider ways to improve our lives. As followers of Jesus Christ, January gives us a reason (in case we need one) to evaluate how we are exercising our faith. Like any sport, activity, or interest, faith requires some sustained practice or attention if we are to grow. If we claim to call Jesus 'Lord', then our relationship with Him and his people is the most important aspect of our lives; the spring from which we experience and process everything else. With that in mind, I'd like to share some personal reflection questions for the new year that I found by a pastor named Don Whitney. It's unrealistic to think you or I would comprehensively address every question on this list, but I hope you will seriously tackle at least a couple of these.

What's one thing you could do this year to increase your enjoyment of God?

What's the most humanly impossible thing you will ask God to do this year?

What's the single most important thing you could do to improve the quality of your family life this year?

In which spiritual discipline do you most want to make progress this year, and what will you do about it?

What is the single biggest time-waster in your life, and what will you do about it this year?

What is the most helpful new way you could strengthen your church?

For whose salvation will you pray most fervently this year?

What's the most important way you will, by God's grace, try to make this year different from last year?

What one thing could you do to improve your prayer life this year?

What single thing that you plan to do this year will matter most in ten years?

In eternity?

This month we complete the series we began in the Fall on Hebrews, going back to what are most likely the most famous chapters in the sermon/letter, #10-11. The focus is on faith, and faith practiced in the midst of challenging circumstances. It begins, 'Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see . . .without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.' (11:1, 6)

May 2017 be the year that we earnestly seek the Lord together! I am excited about the possibilities for us as a congregation and individually as we seek His face.

Happy New Beginnings CUP Family and Friends,


What a whirlwind the past few months have been. I honestly can not even believe it is 2017. A new fresh year is upon us with many memories and footprints to make.
