From the Pastor's Desk...

Dear Cup family and friends,

I know that last August and Labor Day weekend are not, how shall I put it, the most heavily attended of our worship services during the year. But as we enter into the Fall, we're laying out the vision of <u>who</u> <u>we are</u> at Cup church, as well as <u>what we're doing</u> at this time in our life together. In case you missed either message, here's a chance to catch up! (Also, you can catch any sermon you miss by going to our website, cupepc.org, and clicking under 'posts'. You'll find our sermons there.)

First, I described Cup church using the following six words: <u>*Bible-Believing*</u>, <u>*Low Liturgy*</u>, and <u>*Outreach Oriented*</u>. "Bible-Believing", as in looking at Scripture as the Lord's perfect resource for understanding His character and plans – and OUR character as well, and how the Lord addresses our needs, our sin, and our destiny.

"Low Liturgy" means that we use a simple form of shared responses and prayers in the worship service to jointly walk through the gospel message of adoration, confession, forgiveness, and commissioning as God's people each week. "Outreach Oriented" declares that we are a part of the church family – the only organization on earth that exists for non-members! In other words, God calls us into His loving care, and has chosen to work through us to share that message with others who haven't heard, or who haven't understood the implications of Christmas, Good Friday, and Easter.

What we're doing as a church is to grow in effectiveness at being outreach oriented. I've heard it said that those coming into a church for the first time are looking for one of three things: <u>hope</u>, <u>help</u>, or a <u>home</u>. The Triune God offers the comfort of the heavenly Father, the forgiveness of the Son, and the community and joy of the Counselor, the Holy Spirit (John 14:26-27)

There are numerous ways that Cup church offers hope, help, and a home. Many of us have benefitted and been blessed by the Shine mid-week children's ministry, by our game day group, by our choir, and by our various Bible small groups. These initiatives give us opportunities to experience God's goodness and offer it to others at the same time. Yet more and more people in our community are unaware of the gospel message that God is extending to them. This is why we're working on getting to know our neighbors and loving them through invitations to dinner or block parties, a pie offered as a gracious gift, or a willingness to linger in the front yard and have a conversation. As my favorite professor in seminary, Bill Pannell, says, "before people ask, 'Where can I find a merciful God?', they are usually asking, 'Where can I find a merciful neighbor?'' May our neighbors find us to be those good Samaritans (Luke 10:25-37) that carry the good news of great joy!

CUP Library News

A New York Times best-selling book that has been recently added to our library is "A Hobbit, A Wardrobe and a Great War" by Joseph Loconte. Loconte is an Associate Professor of History at the King's College in New York City. He is the author of several books and has written op-eds and essays that have appeared in the New York Times, the Wall Street Journal and other publications. Published in 2015 this book explores how the Great War, better known now as World War I, shaped the lives of two famous writers, J.R.R. Tolkien and C.S. Lewis. Tolkien of course went on to write "The Lord of the Rings" and Lewis wrote "The Chronicles of Narnia". Tolkien and Lewis enjoyed a great friendship that developed in part because of their experiences on the front lines in the war, and Loconte relates how they rediscovered their faith as a result.

A new documentary series about this book is now being developed by the non-profit production company, Eastgate Creative, and is slated for release in November 2018. It should be very interesting and what better way to prepare for viewing the film than to read the book. Our copy can be found under the subject heading of "Christianity in Literature" (813.6).
