## From the Pastor's Desk...

**AUGUST 2020** 

Dear Cup family and friends,

Now listen, you who say, 'Today or tomorrow we will go to this or that city, spend a year there, carry on business and make money.' Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. Instead, you ought to say, 'If it is the Lord's will, we will live and do this or that.'

James 4:13-15

Did James go through a pandemic with his congregation? A passage like this certainly makes me wonder. One of the most challenging aspects of these months for me has been the *uncertainty of planning for the future*. How long do we need to 'stay safe?' When will the situation change for the better, and what will that mean once we get there?

James, in his typically direct manner, points out that we are in control of far less than we think we are. As Americans, we typically like plans, control, and efficient schedules. When nasty little things like viruses pop up and throw a wrench in our plans, we're tempted to lose our patience and lash out in anger – usually at the person closest to us! We believe we can't help worrying or having a short fuse. Pastor Tim Keller calls this 'assumed omniscience.' Assumed omniscience means we really believe we can control it all – or at least far more than is truthfully the case. Even the wisest or strongest among us is unable to do this. James encourages us to lay down the terrible burden of assumed omniscience and put control back in the Lord's hands, where it belongs. This doesn't mean that we don't make an effort to do things and even make plans, but it *does* mean we're called to hold them loosely. This is an exercise in humility, and a healthy one at that.

Like many of you, I pray the day is coming soon where we are able to join together more freely, children will be back in classrooms and 'Shine' ministry, and many of the other things that make Fall such a wonderful time of year, and we're making plans toward that end if events allow it. But until that day, let's ask the Lord for patience with ourselves, our neighbors, and even with Him – because, fortunately, He is God and we are not! This year of 2020 may be giving us an opportunity to look at our own lives reconsider those things, people, and commitments that really matter. Since James has pointed out that we're like the morning mist, let's take the long view and trust these difficulties will soon pass away, but the gifts and glory of God will last forever.


