From the Pastor's Desk...

Dear Cup family and friends,

Many of you know that I'm at work on my Doctoral Thesis, which is in the area of Spiritual Direction. The goal of my work is to help people identify their most natural way of approaching God in prayer, and then providing them with scripture and prayer approaches that 'work' for them, focusing on the beauty (glory) of God. I believe that when we encounter the Lord as he truly is, we will develop hearts and wills that want to 'find out what pleases the Lord' (Eph. 5:10), because we will have discovered that there is no one more pleasing to us than God!

A powerful way for us to approach God is through the practice of reading a short passage of Scripture several times, sometimes called 'Lectio Devina' (Divine Reading). As Presbyterians, we are often good (thankfully so) at reading a Bible passage and gaining information about ourselves or about God from it. The Lectio Devina approach allows us to not only think deeply about a passage, but also encounter our Lord in the passage as well.

For example, one of our small groups read through Mark 4:35-41. This is an account of the disciples with Jesus on the lake. Place yourself in the account as you read.

For the first reading, simply listen for a word or a phrase that catches your attention, and pay extra attention to it. You may want to write it down if you have a journal with you.

After a pause of a couple of minutes, we read the passage aloud again. This time, think about why this particular word or phrase is 'speaking' to you. How might it connect with your life?

After another pause, the text is read aloud a third time. Listen this time for the Lord's invitation to you through his word and the Holy Spirit. Begin a conversation with God. What do you want to say to God about what you are hearing in the text and in your mind and heart? How does the text lead you into prayerful dialogue with God? (Sometimes that 'dialogue' might feel a little more like a wrestling match!)

Finally, we read the text one more time. Simply rest in God's presence now and 'know that he is God.'

God has given us the Scriptures, creation, his Holy Spirit, and so many other gifts so that we can not only know about Him, but to be in relationship with Him. Just as a good marriage or friendship continues to deepen and develop over the years, so our time with God can grow. As we get to know him better, our TRUST grows in Him as well, and that's an amazing gift that will keep on giving in all circumstances! I encourage you try Lectio Devina with any Bible passage, but here are a few more that may be particularly good places to start:

John 1:35-39 Psalm 1, 8, 10, 23 (practically any Psalm) Mark 10:46-52 Genesis 32:22-31 Exodus 3:1-6, 11-14 Matthew 5:14-16, or 5:19-21 (again, practically anything from Matthew 5-7) Ezekiel 36:26 John 8:2-11


