



## From the Pastor's Desk...

April 2023

Dear Cup church family and friends,

Back in 2007 and 2008 I was deeply involved in a congressional campaign. My plan was to finish up college and run for political office. This campaign was the perfect springboard for me. I would make political connections, land a job as a congressional staffer, and prepare to launch my own political campaign one day. For nearly two years, I coordinated volunteers, managed databases, set up yard signs, attended political events, and participated in core team meetings to get him elected. I went all in. As all in as anyone could possibly go. I'll never forget election night. Everyone who I had worked with for two years were gathered together to connect and to see how we did. On the line for me was a job and the springboard to a political future. The night was over practically as soon as it began. From the first reported results, things looked bad. They ended up going from bad to worse. We had lost. I remember having a hard time falling asleep many nights that November and December, thinking about it and asking myself, "What now? What now?" I had gone all in, and now it was over. Well, as you may have guessed, God had other plans for me.

Asking, "what now?" is where CUP is today. I asked the question due to a defeat. For our church, we are asking this question because God has brought us to the point in our church's journey of asking that question. Jesus' disciples were in a similar place after Easter. For 40 days, Jesus was on the earth. Then he ascended to heaven, and his followers were left wondering, what now? What now? In one way, Christ had already told them what to do now. In Matthew 28:19-20, Christ gave them the Great Commission shortly before he ascended to heaven telling them to go, make disciples, baptize, and teach them to obey all he had commanded. However, Acts 1 tells us that they returned to the Upper Room in Jerusalem and devoted themselves to prayer before the Holy Spirit descended upon them at Pentecost.


