From the Pastor's Desk...

Dear Cup family and friends,

The Vision Team has been working hard during Cup's transitional process. The team has concluded the analysis phase of the process and has moved into the vision casting phase. The team reviewed a wide variety of analyses including the Church Life Cycle assessment, the Missional Posture Survey, the SWOT (Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, Threats/Challenges/Barriers) Assessment, and the Know Your Community Assessment. Meanwhile we have also been reading together the book, Canoeing the Mountains: Christian Leadership in Uncharted Territory by Tod Bolsinger. The Vision Team has been a joy to work with. They have a love for the Lord and for Cup Church. They have a passion for the Gospel, and they are invested in Cup fulfilling God's mission.

The missional posture survey is an assessment that analyzes where a church is among five different missional postures, these include non-missional, anti-missional, pre-missional, pro-missional, and post-missional. The assessment resulted in Cup having a three-way tie between pre-missional, pro-missional, and post-missional. Pre-missional is described as the "pastor(s) and/or church leaders are discovering the biblical necessity of making a missional commitment and are open to learning what needs to be done spiritually and strategically in order to go missional." Aka, the church isn't currently on mission, but the church is taking steps towards fulfilling its mission. Pro-missional is described as the "pastor(s) and/or church leaders are fully committed to missional ministry and are actively building missional ministry into the mainstream life of the church." Aka, the congregation is all in for its mission, and it is thriving in it. Finally, pro-missional is the "pastor(s) and church leaders are drifting or pulling away from a previously held missional commitment, either by design or by loss of energy and focus. This is often seen in church plants that become self-supporting and that have achieved sustainable viability. In other words, we've been there done, and we need to refocus on our mission. Cup's three way tie says a lot about it. First, it is neither apathetic nor is it opposed to mission. Second, many people view it as being in its sweet spot on mission. However, there is ambiguity as to where it is on this missional spectrum, so a reenergized, focused, and clarified mission is important.

The Know Your Community report showed that the surrounding community closely mirrors the people of Cup. This is how it should be, but oftentimes congregations do not mirror their community. In this age of mobility, many churches are composed of people who drive in from outside their community. When they attempt to reach their community, they neither know their community nor do they reside, work, or spend recreational time in their church's community. Cup does not have this problem, which is a testament to the successful mission of the church over its lifespan. The report also showed that the people in the community can be more difficult to reach, which is a challenge for our congregation.

Please continue to pray for the vision team, for Cup's next permanent pastor, and for the entire transitional process as we seek the face of God. The Vision Team is praying about and discerning where God is calling our congregation in the areas of evangelism, discipleship, and connection. God is in sovereign control, and may the faithfulness of our congregation and movement of the Holy Spirit move Cup forward as we seek to move into the next phase of ministry.


